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Cpt Code For Sural Nerve

The femoral nerve block (one of the most common nerve blocks, according to a recent ABC client survey) is coded with CPT code 64447 for a single injection and 64448 for a catheter insertion. Currently, the same codes also can be used for adductor canal and saphenous nerve blocks.

However, there are no specific CPT codes for nerve grafting. It is also required for nerve conduction studies to detect demyelination. Doctors often use the median superficial sural artery and nerve to create a flap for correcting anomalies around the foot as well as the ankle.

CPT codes 64400-64530 describe injection of anesthetic agent for diagnostic or therapeutic purposes, the codes being distinguished from one another by the named nerve and whether a

Codingline Response: The CPT code for the tarsal tunnel release is CPT 28035. There is no specific code for the sural nerve "release". I would suggest you use CPT 64704 (neuroplasty; nerve of foot) assuming the decompression was performed at the level of the foot. For the second surgical case, I would suggest CPT 27870 for the arthrodesis ...

There are no specific CPT codes describing sural nerve grafting of the cavernous nerves; the CPT codes describing nerve grafts specifically identify the anatomic site and do not include the cavernous nerves. Therefore, CPT code 64999 (unlisted procedure, nervous system) should be used to describe the nerve

For instance, testing the ulnar nerve at wrist, forearm, below elbow, above elbow, axilla and supraclavicular regions will all be considered as a single nerve. Motor and sensory nerve testing are considered separate tests. CPT code 95905 is payable only once per limb studied and cannot be used in conjunction with any other nerve conduction codes.

OPERATIVE PROCEDURE. The sural nerve is best identified approximately 2 cm posterior to the lateral malleolus and approximately 1-2 cm proximal. In this area, the nerve has not undergone significant branching. The nerve tends to be more posteriorly located than drawn in many texts. A horizontal incision is made in the region above.
