Eligibility For Free Legal Services

A child is eligible for free legal aid till the age of majority i.e. 18 years. This is effectuated by Section 12 (c) of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987. Legal aid is provided free of charge (also called gratuitous legal aid) if the applicant's situation fits the eligibility criteria established by the Act respecting legal aid and the provision of certain other legal services and the Regulation respecting legal aid.

Financial eligibility for Legal Aid Ontario - Legal Aid ...

Legal advice: a minimum contribution of €30 must be paid where your disposable income is less than €11,500. If it is more, your contribution is one-tenth of the difference between €11,500 and your disposable income, up to a maximum of €150.

Civil Legal Advice and Legal Aid - Citizens Information

We may apply the following tests to determine if you are eligible for legal aid. The Jurisdiction Test looks at whether legal aid is available in that jurisdiction and area of law. The Means Test looks at your income and assets. If you are eligible, we look at how much contribution you will pay towards the cost of the service.
