Teaching Point (Strategy): Readers use certain text features (like table of contents, topic, and pictures) to be sure whether a book is fiction or nonfiction. (Students need to come to the carpet with a book.)

ii. Second, have students label the next page in their reader's notebook with the title, Fiction vs. nonfiction texts and draw a t-chart below it. The t-chart should be labeled fiction text features and nonfiction text features. Have students brainstorm elements of fiction (characters, setting, plot, initiating event, problem, resolution, story triangle, etc.) and add them to the chart.
