1. Stay in the stretch zone. Goal-setting is crucial to building self-efficacy. Studies have shown that out of the three personal zones of achievement (the comfort zone, the stretch zone, and the panic zone), highly productive people lie at the stretch zone where they can make the most of their abilities.

Findings indicate that the motivation and self-efficacy of the teachers in fostering HOTS during science teaching are at moderately high level. Significant positive relationships among perceived importance, frequency of practice and level of confidence were observed.

Motivation and Self-efficacy of Science Teachers in ...

Students may use positive self-talk (e.g., "I can do this.") to increase their feelings of self-efficacy (Bandura, 1997). Students may also try to increase their extrinsic motivation by promising themselves a reward after they complete a task ("Once I'm done with this, I can watch a movie.").
