Prepare a bleach solution by mixing: 5 tablespoons (1/3 rd cup) of 5.25–8.25% bleach per gallon of room temperature water or; 4 teaspoons of 5.25–8.25% bleach per quart of room temperature water; Bleach solutions will be effective for disinfection up to 24 hours. Alcohol solutions with at least 70% alcohol may also be used.
