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Reading Comprehension Strategies for English Language ...

Skimming and scanning are usually considered speed-reading skills because they are not used for intensive reading. They are essential skills nonetheless, and students need to know that sometimes intensive reading is not necessary. Skimming a text involves running your eyes over it quickly to get the main idea.

To work on using summarizing for gist, give students a text and three short summaries of it, no longer than a sentence each. After students read the text quickly once, have them choose which of the three summaries best matches the general idea of the text.

Decode and spell that word. Incorporate new words into discussions and activities. For students to really know a word, they must use it—or they will lose it. Use new words in class discussions or outside of class, in other contexts such as on field trips.

In pairs, have students survey the text and use an idea map to record the main idea and details. Ask partners to read the text.

Decoding words strategies are highly important when learning to read. Often, we read and come to a new word that we aren't familiar with.
