The instruments in a orchestral score are written from the highest sounding to the lowest sounding instruments in each of the four sections or the orchestra, woodwinds, brass, percussion, and strings. The type of instruments and the number of instruments being used in the score depend on the composers preference and the composition being written.

Within each group instruments are generally given in score order (see IMSLP:Tagging#Abbreviations for instruments for specific details). The symbols () + and / are used to indicate optional or alternative instrumentation, in the following manner: Examples fl vn pf = for flute, violin and piano (3 instruments)

The shorthand for the instrumentation of a symphony orchestra (and other similar ensembles) is used to outline which and how many instruments, especially wind instruments, are called for in a given piece of music.The shorthand is ordered in the same fashion as the parts of the individual instruments in the score (when read from top to bottom).

What is Film Score Orchestration? In technical terms, orchestration is the process of assigning, in the form of a musical score, a composition complete in form melodically, harmonically, and rhythmically. The task is to designate melody, harmony, and counter melodies to the instruments in the orchestra.
