Fluency Drills are often used during the Orton-Gillingham lessons to help the students practice mastering their newly learned Orton-Gillingham skills. Students are given a fluency practice drill and with a marker across the first line, they read the words as quickly as they can. They will do this with every line increasing their speed over time.

Each grade (K-2) has a methods plan that tells you how to do the multi-sensory approach and complete lesson plans. This is the first grade methods page and the first grade lesson plans. If you were to observe a lesson from an Orton-Gillingham based program such as Wilson, SPIRE or Barton, they would have similarities, but also plenty of differences. The same is true of a non-program-specific Orton-Gillingham lesson plan that follows the Orton-Gillingham approach. The exact lesson sequence may differ depending on where the teacher was trained, the student that they are working with, and what specific skills are being taught.

What Does An Orton-Gillingham Lesson Look Like? - The ...

Practitioner says letter names and student repeats. Student writes the word three times while saying the letter names. Student closes his eyes and traces out the word while saying the letter names. Review the words that were the most difficult for the student.
