File types Excel provides 29 different file types when you save your Excel workbook. When you save an Excel workbook for the first time or use the "Save As" function, you are asked for a folder, file name as well as the file type. By default, Excel suggests the XLSX file type (unless your file doesn't have VBA macros).

Excel 2019 File Formats and Extensions Since the release of Office 2007, all workbook files are saved in an "Open XML" file format by default (a compressed zip file). This file format uses four-letter file extensions (.xlsx,.xlsm,.xlsb,.xltx,.xltm, and.xlam).

Extensions of Excel | Types of File Formats (XLS, XLSX ...

In Microsoft Excel, workbooks are saved as Excel Workbooks (.xlsx) by default. You can change the default file format to any other file format that is supported in Excel. For example, if you frequently create macros in a workbook, you may want to automatically save a new workbook as an Excel Macro-Enabled Workbook (.xlsm).

Change the default file format for saving workbooks - Excel

Office Open XML (OOXML) format was introduced with Microsoft Office 2007 and became the default format of Microsoft Excel ever since. Excel-related file extensions of this format include:.xlsx - Excel workbook.xlsm - Excel macro-enabled workbook; same as xlsx but may contain macros and scripts

XLSX/XLSM saves it as an XML file and XLSB saves it as a binary (.bin) file. And without getting too technical, XML files are large in size as compared to a binary file. So when you save your Excel workbook in the XLSB format, the file size is reduced. In our above example, the size reduction was ~30%.

Click the File tab and then choose Save As. The Save As dialog box appears. Enter a name and select a location for your workbook. Click the Save as Type drop-down arrow.

Microsoft Office Excel 2007+ files can be 'Saved As' in several other formats besides the default XLSX format. The file formats that are available in the Save As dialog box may vary, depending on what type of sheet is active (e.g. a worksheet, chart sheet). Save As Binary in Excel 2007

XLSX or XLSB: Why to save a workbook in binary format

An Excel macro-enabled workbook. The file information is stored in binary format rather than as XML documents. This file format is approximately twice as fast as .xlsx at opening and saving Excel workbooks. This is particularly useful for very large files (greater than 10MB).

NOTE: When Excel saves a workbook to one of the CSV or text formats, which are specified by using the FileFormat parameter, it saves these formats in logical layout. If left-to-right (LTR) text is embedded within right-to-left (RTL) text in the file, or vice versa, logical layout saves the contents of the file in the correct reading order for all languages in the file without regard to direction.

If the excel is saved in the form of XLSX or XLSM excel workbook tends to slow down. XLSB means Excel Binary Workbook. If you save the workbook as a binary workbook it will reduce the weight of the workbook. Look at the below image an excel workbook saved in the form of XLSX and the total workbook weight is 63.4 Kb.
