If the light from the flash is too bright, photographs will be too bright (overexposed) ; if it is not bright enough, photographs will be too dark (underexposed). Immediately before the shutter is released, the built-in flash units in Nikon DSLR Cameras emit low-intensity flashes (monitor pre-flashes) to measure the amount of light reflected from the subject.
